urrently holding the best coaching record in Canadian soccer history, Bob Lenarduzzi was appointed as Canada's World Cup and Olympic teams coach in February 1990 to become the first full-time Canadian-born to guide Canada through International competition. He coached Canada in fiftyfour full "A" international games, breaking Tony Waiters record of 43 games that was achieved over six years.

Bob has coached and managed the Vancouver 86ers of the Canadian Soccer League during the six-year existence of the league. In the process, he led the 86ers to five regular season titles and six championship final appearances, having won the title four consecutive times between 1986 and 1991. member of the Canadian World Cup and Olympic teams between 1973 and 1986, he played in the 1984 Los Angeles Olympic Games and the 1986 World Cup finals in Mexico. He has earned 47 "A" International appearances and represented Canada in eight Olympic team matches.

Born in Vancouver, British Columbia, he signed a professional contract with F.C. Reading of the English Fourth Division at age 15. Between 1973 and 1996, he represented Canada 47 times as a player and has coached Canada 50 times for a total of 97 games being involved with Canada at the International level. This amounts to 51% of Canada's total international games (191) since 1885 when Canada played its first ever international match.

In 1978, he became the first Canadian to be named North American Player of the Year. In 1991, he was named Canadian Soccer League General Manager of the year; in 1992, he became the first full-time Canadian-born to coach Canada's National Team and was inducted into the B.C Sports Hall of Fame.
