Spring 2000 CIBPA Dinner May 11th, Old Fort William

Peter Andersen is an independent consulting economist specializing in economic forecasting. After obtaining a doctorate in economics from Harvard University, Dr. Andersen joined the research staff of the Bank of Canada. At the Bank, he was responsible for advising the Governor and Bank of Canada management on economic conditions and the economic outlook.

Peter became the Assistant Chief of the Bank of Canada's Research Department before moving to Toronto to join Woods Gordon, now Ernst & Young.

As a partner with this national consulting firm, Dr. Andersen directed its economic forecasting practice and acted as an economic consultant and advisor to a wide range of companies. In his corporate consulting practice, he has always empha-

sized communication and the need to put economic analysis into terms that are useful for business decision-making.

Dr. Andersen then spent several years as Chief Economist with a leading investment dealer firm, Burns Fry, now Nesbitt Burns. In 1984, Peter founded Andersen Economic Research Ltd. His clients are widely distributed across a broad range of corporations and financial institutions throughout Canada and the United States. He also acts as a consulting economist for the Canadian Home Builders' Association and Sprott Securities Limited.

He continues to focus on providing strategic economic advice to management with regular client meetings and regular economic reports.

And as with all of our events, sponsors who donate gifts add all that very important touch — a piece of the game that says 'you are acknowledged for your participation'.


