Dr. Frederick F. Gilbert, President & Vice-Chancellor LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY

Dr. Frederick F. Gilbert was appointed as Lakehead University's fifth President and Vice-Chancellor in July 1998. He is currently a Board Member of the Living Legacy Trust, the Northern Ontario Medical School (Chair), and the Northwestern Ontario Technology Centre. He also is a member of the Advisory Council to the Nuclear Waste Management Organization.

Before joining Lakehead, Dr. Gilbert was Vice-Provost of Colorado State University. From 1992 to 1997 he held the posi-

tion of Founding Dean of the Faculty of Natural Resources and Environmental Studies at the University of Northern British Columbia.

Previously he held academic administrative appointments at Washington State University, the University of Guelph and the University of Maine.

Dr. Gilbert's academic interests include wildlife management, environmental studies and natural resources science. He holds a B.Sc (Hons) degree in Biology from Acadia University and MSc and PhD degrees in Zoology from the University of Guelph. He has supervised a total of 25 Master's and PhD students and has coauthored over 60 refereed publications, several book chapters and two books in his areas of expertise.




advantage of this opportunity and bring a guest to a dinner that promises to be very informative.


