Recording Success for Local CIBPA Member

Thunder Bay band, Star74 was founded in 2001 when Carlo Cappello placed "runner-up" in a nation-wide songwriting contest. At the time Carlo was heading a shortlived yet moderately successful band, False Prophets, which was scouted by a prominent Los Angeles radio promotion and management company. In 2002, Carlo received an invitation to showcase his EASTBOUND music in Los Angeles. Later that year, he went to L.A. and met with A&R executives from Dreamworks Records and was in the stages of developing a relationship with their A&R department. It was at this time that Carlo began writing songs



for what would become Star74's debut CD, "DRIVE," which was released in December 2004. In producing the album, Carlo enlisted the help of musician/producer, Luke Gladu, drummer Stu Green, and bassist Derek Jackson. Together they recorded the band's first album.

Since that time, the band has sold well over 1000 units of their debut album in addition to many individual songs on various online sites such as iTunes. Star74 have also enjoyed medium to high rotation on approximately 22 radio stations around the globe. Described musically as a cross between John Mayer and the Counting Crows, Star74's first single, "Believe" is regularly played on Rock 94.3fm, CILU 102.7fm in Thunder Bay, CAFE102.5fm in Winnipeg, and many other college/university and commercial stations in Canada, the US, Australia and Europe. Star74 has played far too many shows to remember and has shared the stage with the likes of The Trews and Nazareth (yes, Nazareth) to name a couple. They also had the fortune of being the opening band for the Rock the Fort music festival at Fort William Historical Park in 2005.

Star74 are in the process of writing material for a follow-up album that is scheduled to be released in the fall. As Carlo and the band continue to grow and develop their sound they all agree on one thing: nothing worth remembering was created overnight . . . and they plan on being around for a while.
