CHIEF ROBERT P. HERMAN
Chief of Police, Thunder Bay Police Service

Chief Bob Herman was born and raised in Thunder Bay. In his youth he was involved in Navy League Cadets and Sea Cadets and served 14 years in the Army Reserves. Chief Herman attended Confederation College where he was granted a diploma in Aviation Administration Management in 1979.

Chief Herman joined the Thunder Bay Police Service in 1980. During the next decade he worked in Uniform Patrol, Intelligence Unit, Drug Unit and Criminal Investigation Branch. In 1990 Chief Herman worked in Human Resources and Training Unit for the Thunder Bay Police Service. In 1991, Chief Herman was promoted to the rank of Sergeant. He then worked as a patrol supervisor, media officer and eventually became the Case Manager and lead Detective of major investigations and Homicides in the Criminal Investigations Branch.



In 1997, he was promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief of Police and became responsible for all police operations in Thunder Bay which included Criminal Investigations, Intelligence, Patrol and Community Services.

In October of 2000, he was appointed as the Chief of Police for the Thunder Bay Police Service. Chief Herman is President of the Ontario Association of Chiefs. He is Past Chair of the Criminal Intelligence Service of Ontario and a past member of the Executive of the Criminal Intelligence Service of Canada. He was Honourary Chair of the 2011 Ontario Winter Special Olympics.

Chief Herman initiated a 4 year Diversity in Policing project in Thunder Bay in 2005 which included biased free policing training for all Thunder Bay Police Service members.

Chief Herman has been awarded the Canadian Forces Decoration, Police Exemplary Service Medal, Thunder Bay Police Services Board's Exceptional Service Award for criminal Investigations and has received numerous commendations during his career.

Chief Herman is an Accredited Certified Municipal Manager Level III with a Police Executive designation.

## Recipe - Peter Niccoli Roasted Sausages, Peppers, Potatoes and Onions

#### Chef Pedro

#### Serves 4

- 1 pound potatoes, peeled and cut into 1 inch chunks
- 1 green bell pepper, cored, seeded, and cut into 1 inch pieces
- 1 red bell pepper, cored, seeded, and cut into 1 inch pieces
- 1 medium onion, cut into 1 inch chunks ¼ cup olive oil Salt and freshly ground pepper
- 1 pound Italian-style pork sausages

#### Preparation

- Preheat oven to 450F
- Spread the vegetables in a single layer in one or more large shallow roasting pans; do not crowd them, or they will not brown.
- Drizzle with the oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper to taste. Stir well.
- Roast the vegetables, stirring once or twice, for 45 minutes.
- Pierce each sausage in 2 or 3 places with a fork. Place the sausages on top of the vegetables
- Bake for 15 to 30 minutes, or until the sausages and vegetables are cooked through.
- Serve hot. .




