Recipe - Peter Niccoli - Fiori Di Zucca Fritti

Ingredients: Serves 4

- ♦ 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup cornstarch
- Salt and freshly ground pepper
- ¹/₂ cup sparkling mineral water
- Vegetable oil for deep-frying
- 16 zucchini or other squash blossoms



Preparation

- In a small bowl, whisk together
 the flour, cornstarch, ½ teaspoon salt, and pepper to taste.
- Stir in the water.
- Let stand for 1 hour.
- Pour 2 inches of oil into a deep fryer or deep heavy saucepan.
- Heat over medium heat until the temperature reaches 375F
 on a deep-frying thermometer, or a drop of the batter sizzles and quickly rises to the surface of the oil.

- Dip a zucchini flower in the batter, coating it completely.
- Slip into the oil. Dip and add only as many more flowers as fit without crowding the pan.
- Fry, turning once, for 1 to 2 minutes, until crisp.
- Remove the flowers from the pan with a slotted spoon, and drain on paper towels.
- Fry the remainder, and serve immediately.
