

Tech Tips - Ransomware - Joe Daniele

What is Ransomware?

Ransomware is a nasty virus software that encrypts your files. Once the files are encrypted they cannot be used. If you double click on the file it will not open. Ransomware cannot be removed. There have only been a few of the early versions that have been solved and fixes provided. There are many different variations of ransomware, some infect only your documents while others infect all your files including files that run your computer or server. Once infected the virus will ask you for money to provide the decrypting key. After 1 week they double the price of the decryption key. Usually after 2 weeks you can no longer contact them for the decryption key.

What to do if Infected by Ransomware?

If you are infected by the virus then the virus will have to be stopped and if possible removed. Once the virus is stopped then you will have to determine which files are infected. If just the data files are infected you can restore them from your latest backup. If both the data files and system files are infected you will need to reload your computer or server and then restore your data files from your latest backup.

How to prevent getting Ransomware?

Make sure you have a good anti virus program running. Having just an anti virus program running is not enough. You should always have a backup system that makes a duplicate copy of your files. You should also have multiple copies of backups. There are many styles of backup systems. To find the right backup system you should consult an computer expert. Having only 1 hard drive constantly connected to your computer is not enough protection. This virus travels through mapped drives. A backup hard drive is usually mapped to your computer and the result is having your files on your backup getting infected. Educate yourself and users to not click on every email you get if you do not know where it is coming from.

What happens if you do not have a backup of your files?

If you have no backup and you need those files you will have to pay the price they are asking for the decryption key. This is a lengthy process and should be done as quick as possible. Once again contact a computer expert who has done this to help you with the process.


