Recipe - Peter Niccoli - Calamari Fritti

Ingredients: Serves 6 - 8

- 2 pounds cleaned calamari (squid)
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Freshly ground pepper
- Olive oil or vegetable oil for deep-frying
- · Lemon wedges

Preparation

- Rinse the calamari thoroughly inside and out.
- Drain well.

- Cut the bodies crosswise into 1/2 inch rings.
- Cut the tentacles in half through the base.
- Pat dry.
- Spread the flour on a sheet of wax paper and season with salt and pepper to taste.
- Pour 2 inches of oil into a deep heavy saucepan or a deep fryer.
- Heat the oil to 375F on a deep-frying thermometer, or until a small piece of the

- calamari sizzles and rises to the surface when added to the oil.
- When the temperature is reached, lightly roll a few pieces of calamari in the flour mixture.
- Shake off the excess flour.
- Slip the pieces into the hot oil, without crowding the pan, and cook until the calamari are light golden brown, about 3 minutes.
- With a slotted spoon, transfer the calamari to paper towels to drain.
- Repeat with the remaining calamari.
- Serve hot with lemon wedges.


