Giovanni B. ladeluca, CPA, CA Chief Executive Officer – AV Terrace Bay, Canada

Giovanni ladeluca is the Chief Executive Officer of AV Terrace Bay (AVTB) in North Western Ontario, Canada. He assumed this role in 2012 and is responsible for driving innovation, operational excellence and continuous improvement of products and processes at AVTB.

Currently, Mr. ladeluca is responsible for leading the conversion of the mill, from its current production of paper grade pulp to dissolving grade pulp with a capacity of 280,000 TPA, in a phased manner. He oversees and supports production activities to drive quality and manage cost. Mr. ladeluca also focuses on community development initiatives and strengthening relationships with various stakeholders, including First Nations and various government agencies.



Mr. ladeluca studied at Concordia University in Montreal and holds a bachelor's degree in Commerce and Information Technology; A master's degree in Accountancy and is a Chartered Accountant with membership in the Order of Chartered Accountants of Quebec.

Mr. ladeluca has successfully led and managed several complex assignments including investment projects, process and productivity enhancements, cost optimisation, integration of manufacturing best practices, financial planning and analysis.

Prior to joining the Aditya Birla Group, Mr. Iadeluca was Chief Executive Officer at Selenis Canada Inc. He has also worked in various senior leadership roles with other public and private organisations including PTT Poly Canada (Shell Chemicals and Government of Quebec JV), Bath Fitters Inc. and GSI Technologies USA Inc.

Recipe - Peter Niccoli - Pasta e Patate

Ingredients: Serves 6 - 8

- 2 thick slices pancetta or 4 slices of bacon, chopped
- I small carrot, peeled and chopped
- 1 small celery rib, chopped
- I medium onion, chopped
- 1 garlic clove, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh flat-leafy parsley
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon tomato paste

- Salt and freshly ground pepper
- 1 ½ pounds boiling potatoes, peeled and diced
- 6 cups of water
- 12 ounces of ditalini or elbow macaroni
- 2 cups of boiling water
 - ½ cup freshly grated Pecorino Romano or Parmigiano ◆ -Reggiano

Preparation

 Chop the pancetta, carrot, celery, onion and parsley together.

- Pour the oil into a large saucepan.
- Add the chopped mixture, and cook over medium-low heat until the vegetables are tender and golden. Stir in the tomato paste and salt and pepper to taste.
- Add the potatoes and water.
- Bring to a simmer, and cook until the potatoes are very tender, about 30 minutes.

- Mash some of the potatoes with the back of a spoon.
- Add the pasta and boiling water.
- Cook, stirring often, until the pasta is tender.
- The mixture should remain quite thick, but add more water if it seems too thick.
- Stir in the cheese and serve immediately.
