Recipe - Peter Niccoli - Black Bean Burgers

Ingredients: Serves 6 - 8

- 2 cans black beans, rinsed and drained
- ♦ 1 onion, minced
- ♦ 3 garlic cloves, minced
- ♦ 2 carrots, shredded
- ♦ ½ cup quick oats
- ♦ 1 Tbsp soy sauce
- ♦ 1 Tbsp, olive oil
- ♦ 1 tsp cumin

- ♦ ½ tsp coriander
- ♦ ½ tsp chili powder
- ♦ ¼ tsp cayenne pepper
- ♦ Salt and pepper
- ♦ Buns

Preparation

- Heat one tablespoon of olive oil in a pan.
- ◆ Combine onions, garlic, salt and pepper and cook until

- onions are translucent.
- Add carrots, cumin, coriander, chili powder, and cayenne pepper until carrots are tender.
- Remove pan from heat.
- In a bowl, mash the beans and then add the contents of the pan along with the soy sauce and quick oats.
- Mix and form four patties.

- Place in freezer for 30 minutes to set.
- Cook patties on a pan coated in cooking spray over medium heat, flipping half way.
- Use patties and create your dream veggie burger.




